GENERAL RULES:

- Individual Event.

- Prelims will be conducted(Written).

- Team Event (Each team should have two members).
- Prelims will be conducted (written).
- For finals, evaluation will be done based on the merit and depth of discussion.
- Time limit will be 15 minutes for each group.

GAMING

- Individual Event.
- NFS-Most Wanted or Counter Strike will be the game provided.
- Number of rounds will be determined by the number of participants.

GRAPHIC DESIGNING

- Individual event.
- Participants are not allowed to carry any storage media.
- All the required materials will be provided.
- Design Tool: Adobe Photoshop CS3
- Duration : 1 hour

QUIZ

- Two members team is allowed from a college.
- Quiz based on IT, GK and Current affairs.
- Prelims will be conducted based on the number of participants.
- Only five teams will be selected for final.
- Decisions by the Quiz master will be final.

SEMINAR PRESENTATION

- Synopsis and soft copy of seminar paper should be submitted on or before 19th Feb 2012.
- Individual or a two member's team.
- 15 minutes for presentation and 5 minutes for interactive session.
- Necessary tools for presentation can be used. (Slides, chart, etc.)
- Irrelevant topics will be rejected.
- Status of the sent topics will be informed.

TREASURE HUNT

- A team should have 4 members.
- There will be 8 levels for the event.
- Time allotted for the event is 1.30 hours.
- The decision of the coordinators will be final.
- Those who violate the rules will be disqualified.
