Report of the Academic Year 19-20

The activities of Fine arts & Literary Club for the year 2019-20 began with a **Logo designing contest** conducted as part of the Gandhi Smruthy- the 150th Birth Anniversary celebrations of Mahatma Gandhi by MES Calicut on 2 August 2019. 34 students participated in the competition. Mr. Ydhu Krishnan M R, S3 BSc. Microbiology secured first prize and was awarded Rs.5000/- and a certificate by the College Managing Committee. Mr. Sujith A A and Mr. Muhammed Rizwan of S1 BVoc Animation & Graphics Design were in the 2nd and 3rd positions respectively.

On 19 August 2019 an **essay writing competition** was conducted in connection with 34th K R Mehta Memorial Inter Collegiate Essay Competition on the topic 'You will never do great things if you can't do small things in a great way' to be held on 27 August 2019 at Indian Chamber of Commerce & Industry, Mattancherry.
