Fine Arts and Literary Club Report of the Academic Year 20-21



Students compiled suggestions to better and enhance higher education in Kerala and handed over the file to Chief Minister. A copy of suggestions is attached with this report.



Suggestions:

- 1. Try and align UG curriculum in line with industrial standards by periodically upgrading elective courses in the Syllabus. Industries shall offer professional courses in the campuses in order to bridge the industry academia disconnect
- 2. Merit based selection of students to carry out internships in Government funded research organisations/industries
- 3. Redesign Professional UG programs like BCA as micro level certification programs in each semester with provisional exit
- 4. Student exchange programme utilising the great Kerala Cooperative model to provide selected students an opportunity to do their part of graduation in world's best universities
- 5. Enhance Kerala Start up Mission to incorporate a Kudumbasree like structure to help with women and transgender students entrepreneurs
- 6. Credit transfer facility and attendance flexibility for the students taking Part-time job, Online-courses, entrepreneurs and advanced learners shall be considered
- 7. Offer more asynchronous courses, so that students who are unable to register for regular courses can also pursue higher education
- 8. Provide tax exemptions to companies who promote differently abled and transgender intake
