
APRIL








WORLD ATHLETICS DAY

MOTHER'S DAY





WORLD BLOOD DONOR DAY



BOTANIC HEAVEN



75TH INDEPENDENCE DAY



NATIONAL SPORTS DAY




SELECTION FOR IGC


ALL INDIA TREKKING CAMP














INDIAN NAVY DAY

FELICITATES CADETS WHO VOLUNTEEREND IN COVID CAMP



BASIC LIFE SUPPORT AND FIRST AID TRAINING PROGRAM






FIRING SELECTION
