### **ACTIVITY REPORT FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2022-23**

Essay writing competition in English and Malayalam based on the theme “Democracy and Secularism in Present Indian Scenario” was conducted at the library hall and twenty-two students participated in it. Ms. Fassam Aboobacker(S3 MA English) secured the first prize and Ms. Atheela Ibrahim(S3 MA English) and Ms. Rasiya Mahin(S3 BA English) shared the second prize for English essay writing competition.
