Report of Webinar on "Career Opportunities in Electronics Industry"


An international technical talk on "Career Opportunities in Electronic Industry" has been conducted on 25 July 2020. The talk is delivered by Ms. Malarvizhi M, Design Engineer, Infineon Technologies, United Kingdom. Final year BSc Electronics, final year BSc Physics and First and second year MSc Electronics and Physics students were the targeted audience.

The session started at 2.30pm. Dr. Farzana S Hussain, Co-ordinator, Placement Cell delivered the welcome speech. Report of webinar on "Career Planning"


