

DE TALENTO-CULTURAL EVENTS








INTERNATIONAL DAY FOR THE ELIMINATION OF VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN










HUMAN RIGHTS DAY







Approximately 690 Kg waste was collected during the project and were segregated into 7 categories – biomedical waste, hazardous waste (electronic waste), broken glass waste, metal waste, paper and organic waste and miscellaneous waste



(include footwear, clothing residual waste) etc. Recyclable waste was recycled using another agency. The cleaning activity gained great public support and appreciation from the GCDA Cochin Corporation and media.
