

## REPORT OF WOMEN CELL 2016-17

Women Cell 2016-17 of MES College, Marampally conducted several activities for female students which were very relevant in the present scenario. Cell conducted regular meetings in which the problems, issues and challenges those were faced by the girls were discussed and remedial measures were taken time to time.

Two representatives from each class were selected and the first meeting of the representatives and coordinators was conducted on 15.06.2016. In this meeting Hirunniza of II B.Sc. Mathematics, Aysha of III BCA and Lidiyamol of II B.Sc. Psychology were selected as Secretary, Joint Secretary and Treasure respectively. Action Plan for the year was also prepared in this meeting.

On 13<sup>th</sup> July 2016 Women Cell organized a program – **“Campaign against Child Abuse and Violence against Women “** by Bodhini Team. Bodhini Team discussed the problems those have been faced by the women and children in the society and the precautions that must be taken by them. It was a three hour interactive session and the students actively participated in the session. Many students made use of this. The students gave an excellent feedback and they demanded more such session for boys also.



The Women Cell and Dept. of Psychology jointly conducted an awareness class on “**Health and Hygiene**” to female students and hostel inmates on 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2016.

On 10.02.2017 forty student representatives and women cell coordinators visited the inmates of the old age home at Chungamveli. An amount of Rs.12000/- and consumable items were given to them. Students arranged lunch and cultural programs for the inmates.



To conduct the cutting and tailoring class, four sewing machines and one embroidery machine were bought with the financial support of PTA. Dr. Susan Varghese, Joint Coordinator, Sandra Mary Offer and Rameesa Rahman, members women cell participated in the Two day state level national Seminar on “Extent

and Intensity of Crime and Violence against Women and Children” held on 27 – 28 February 2017. Dr. Susan Varghese, Joint Coordinator, Sandra Mary Offer member women cell also presented the paper on “A Study on Quality of life & Stress tolerance among women traffic polices” in the seminar.

The Women cell conducted a three day activity oriented self-defense program for first year undergraduate & post graduate female students on 28th of February to 2nd of March 2017 which has utmost importance in the present scenario. Smt .Usha, SI, Women Cell of Police, Aluva Rural inaugurated the program. She gave an insight to the students about the various measures that can be undertaken to curb the atrocities against women and demonstration and practical classes were handled by Smt. Usha & her team. In these practical sessions they conveyed the different tactics to escape from a sudden attack to the students. The team also enlightened our students with the different ways to make sure the safety of women. All the students actively participated in the session.



The cell celebrated the women’s day by conducting poster designing competition and paper bag making competitions for the students. Aliya Faisal and

Hana bagged first and second prizes respectively for poster designing. Hazeena T.S. and Devipriya K.S. got first prize and Noushin and Hana got second prize for paper bag making. Amritha Jayakumar of M.Sc. Computer Science prepared a video on the role of women in the society and played it in the common display system of the college on 08.03.2017.

The cell made its active role in the hygiene of ladies toilets and maintenance of incinerator. Group of students were selected and charges were given to them in monitoring the toilets hygiene and maintenance of incinerator.
