

He portrayed the history and socio cultural specialties of Lakshadweep in detail. Mr. Kamal, Chairman, Kerala State Chalachithra Academy, was the key speaker of the event. He shared

More than 100 participants were attended the meeting and the meeting provided an excellent platform for the discussion of pros and cons of proposed administrative reforms.

The second program was conducted on 9<sup>th</sup> September 2021 on the title, “Revisit to Malabar Rebellion”. The program was conducted in connection with the centenary celebration of Malabar rebellion, one of the major events in the history of Indian Independence Movement.
