### **Consolidated Report of Scholar Support Programme**

#### **Scholar Support Programme (SSP) 2018-19**

The Scholar Support Programme during the academic year 2018-19, has been started in MES College, Marampally on September 2018. The government sanctioned Rs 85500/- as per the Govt.Order.No:P4/13804/2018/Coll.Edn.Dept. dt 13.12.2018 to conduct the programme. The programme was conducted only for first year students. The selection of the students was on the basis of the marks obtained in the qualifying examination and tutor's evaluation.

Forty students from various departments are enrolled in this programme. Applications were collected from the students and the most difficult subject from each Programme (4 Programmes – In MES College, Marampally we have only four aided Programmes) was identified. The internal mentors were selected based on the choice of students and the willingness of the resource persons. 7 sessions for each subject in each semester were completed on time. Odd semesters completed in December 2018 and even semesters in February 2019. Classes were taken after the normal working hours of the college or in Saturdays and holidays. The attendance sheet for each programmes are maintained separately. For each internal mentors 8 students are allotted for mentoring, then the total internal mentors are 5 for each semester programmes. The government granted Rs 35000/- for internal mentoring sessions and also provide a stationery kit for students for Rs 2000/.

The Coordinator Smt.Sufaira Shamsudeen attended the SSP Coordinators' one day training conducted on September 11<sup>th</sup> 2018 at Loyola College, Trivandrum. All the Programmes related to SSP were discussed with the monitoring Committee in the college.

The external mentoring classes for Life Skills and Learning Skills led by Mrs. Elizabeth Ipe, Mr.Sivasree M.S, Mr. Rohith N.R, Mr. Siby K.M, famous motivational speakers and ASAP trainers were conducted and most of the students attended the programme. The external mentoring classes for IT Skills are handled by resource persons Mrs. Jesla Joseph, Mrs. ReseenaMol N.A, Mrs.Indu Sussan Varghese, Mrs. Simna C.A, and Mrs.Minu Muhammed, Computer Application Department faculties of our institution as per the order from the State Coordinator Dr. Murugan K. Classes were taken in Saturdays and holidays. All classes were really appreciated and motivated.









The programme helped a lot to impart personalized additional support to academically weak and interested students through tutorials, study materials, printed notes, solved question papers, additional lectures, question banks and interactive sessions. The classes were organized on the basis of university previous question papers that helped the needy students to appear the examinations. Grant sanctioned and allotted during the year 2018-19 was Rs 85,500/- and was fully utilized.
