As a part of the Interdepartmental activities, Electronics Department offers Short Term Course in MATLAB to the students of B.Sc. Mathematics every year. This course is offered for 25 hours through 3 semesters. The objective of the course is how to use MATLAB as hands on Mathematics to engage students and facilitate critical thinking while implementing the common core standards of mathematical practice. The course mainly focuses on Symbolic Math tool box. Symbolic math tool box provides functions for solving and manipulating symbolic math expressions and performing variableprecision arithmetic. Using this tool box, the students can analytically perform differentiation, integration, simplification, transforms and equation solving. The workshop is given to the second year batch of B.Sc. Mathematics. The course curriculum is designed and the sessions are handled by the faculty members Smt. Shemi PM and Smt. Shareena E M. First and the second session of the short term course has been held on 30 Dec 2015 and 11 Jan 2016. The remaining sessions will be conducted during their fifth semester period, from June - September 2016.
