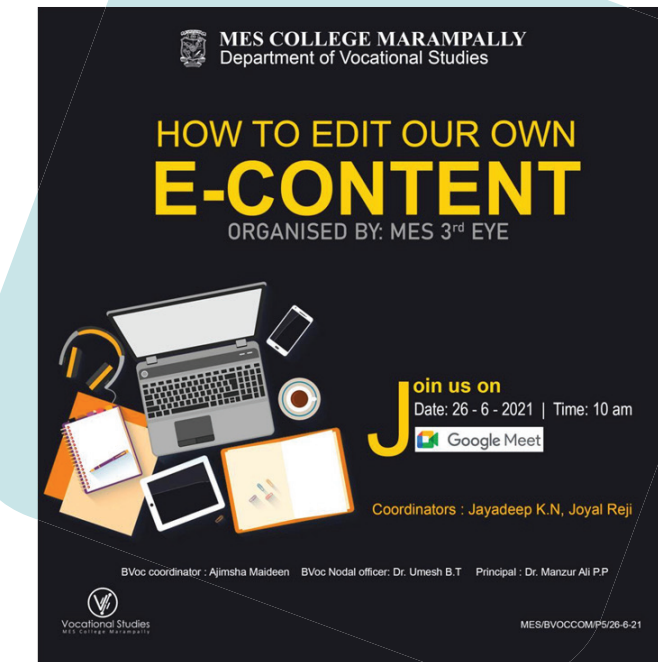
It's really a wonderful evening for the students to showcase their singing talents and they got some free time from their busy academic schedule.

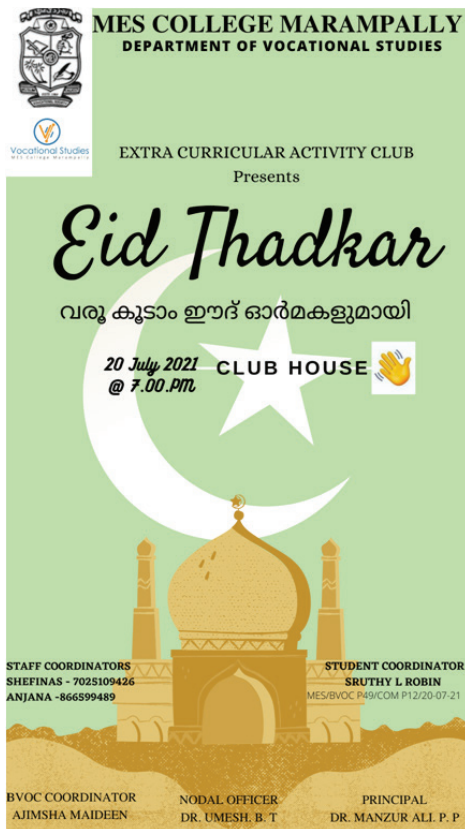

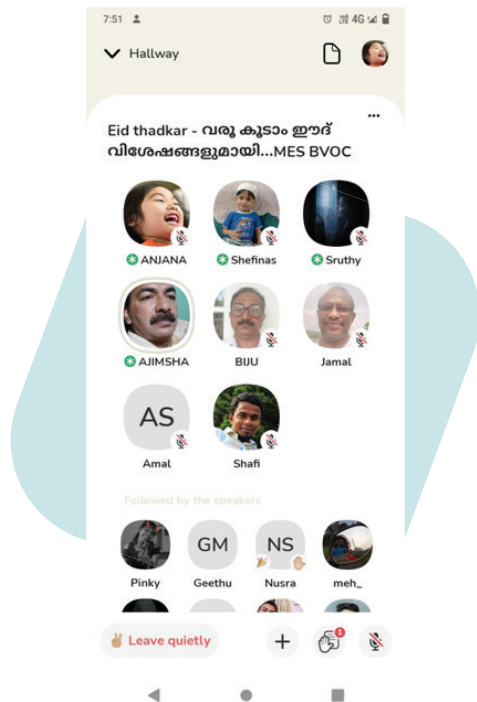

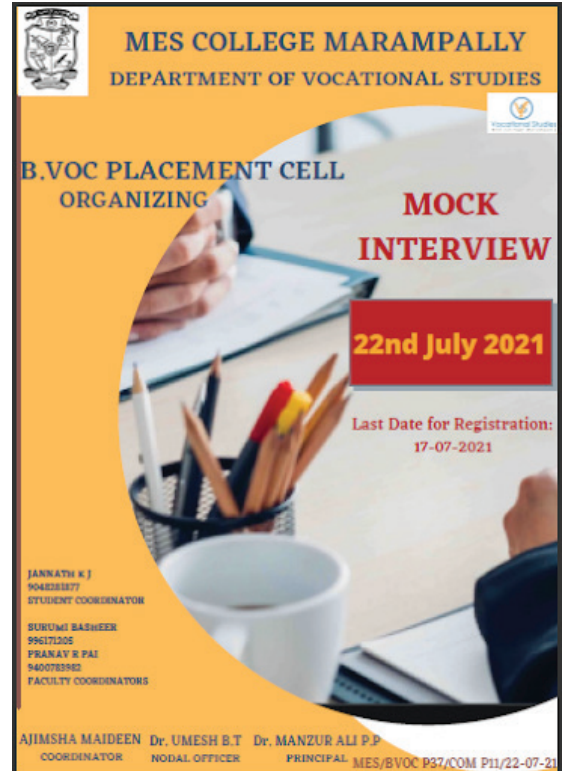


# MOCK INTERVIEW

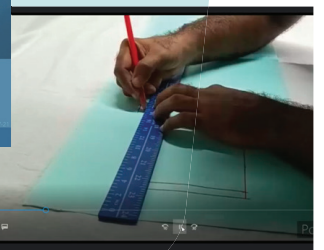
Ms. Geethu Merin Antony, HOD, Department of Fashion Design & Management gave the presidential address.
