The main aim of the conference was to bring together academicians and researchers to share the acme of scientific knowledge in different disciplines viz Computer Science and Applications, Electronics and Instrumentation, Life Sciences, Physical and Mathematical Sciences, Humanities, Social Sciences, and Physical Education. ICHT2022 presents an open forum for scientists, academicians, researchers, engineers, industry experts, analysts, business managers and practitioners, and students to exchange the latest innovations and research advancements in various areas. It will be a unique platform offering deliberations on multiple dimensions of Innovation, Technology, Management, and Humanity.

The six days International Conference was inaugurated by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of MG University Prof. (Dr.) Sabu Thomas on 17<sup>th</sup> January 2022 at 9.30 am. After the official inauguration, the Book of Abstracts was released by Adv. A A Abul Hassan, Secretary of College Managing Committee.

This was the first international conference hosted by MES College Marampally, incorporating all the departments of the college. The conference was divided into seven tracks, namely Computer Science, Electronics, Life Sciences, Physical and Mathematical Sciences, Humanities, Social Sciences, and Physical Education, which were held simultaneously on the Zoom platform, owing to the current pandemic situation.

In total, we had 19 keynote speeches by eminent speakers from various institutions all over the world and about 50 paper presentations.

The closing ceremony of the six days International Conference was inaugurated by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of the National University of Advanced Legal Studies (NUALS), Prof. (Dr.) K C Sunny on 22 January 2022 at 2.00 pm. The function was presided over by Dr. Jasmine P M, Principal of MES College Marampally. Ms. Jaseena K U, Organizing Secretary of ICHT 2022 presented the report of the programme. Best paper awards were announced during the function.

ICHT 2022 has helped renew focus and attention on the importance of Sustainable development and how technology and humans have to carefully plan and implement revised courses of action for its survival and existence in the times ahead.
