#### EID CELEBRATIONS 2022



Also known as the Festival of the Sacrifice, the Greater Eid and the Major Festival, Eid ul-Adha is celebrated in the last month of the lunar Islamic calendar. Over the three days of Eid ul-Adha, Muslims mark the end of the great pilgrimage to Mecca and commemorate Abraham's sacrifice, when he unflinchingly agreed to surrender his son in the name of faith. Eid ul-Adha is widely recognized as a time for prayer, reflection, philanthropy and community building, as Muslims across the globe share bounties and honor familial and communal bonds. However, unlike Onam or Christmas, those celebrating Eid rarely have official school or work breaks for the three-day holiday. College students may struggle to balance Eid celebrations with academic work, especially as overdue term papers and exams pepper the first few weeks of new academic year.



Fine Arts and Literary Club, MES College Marampally, organized Eid Celebrations under the theme: “Qurban Heyit- festival of Sacrifice” on July 8, 2022 from 2pm -4pm, at BVoc block (Badminton Court), with Dr. Sheeba K.H as Coordinator and a team of five Joint coordinators. The event began with a silent prayer. This was followed by a Welcome Address by one of the Arts student coordinators, Ms Raich Alna Roy. Dr. Ajims P Muhammed, Principal delivered the inaugural address and gave away the Eid message to students. Dr .Shemi P, Staff Association Secretary offered felicitation. 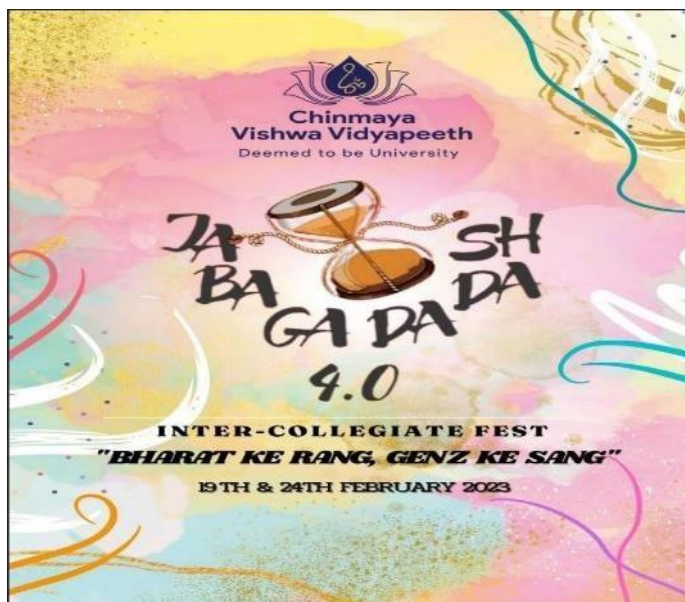
