
Q1.1 EXPERT TALK ON STARTUP INNOVATIONS & OPPORTUNITIES








Q1.2 INTRODUCTION TO INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS






Q2.5 UDAAN 2021 :" TAP INTO YOUR INNER POTENTIALS" BY DHANYA RAVI






Q2.8 INTERACTION WITH INNOVATION AMBASSADOR AND ORIENTATION ON IIC




Q2.11 WEBINAR ON INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS




Q2.13 3D PRINTING WORKSHOP




Q2. 15 INDUSTRY 4.0-Career search through Innovative Technology




On February 28, 2022, Department of Fashion Design and Management in association with Institution's Innovation Council conducted a My Story - Motivational session by a successful








Q3.2 AWARENESS PROGRAM ON INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS


Q4.10 AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON IPR






Q4.11 SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY POST INDEPENDENCE










Q4.16 TALK ON INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS
