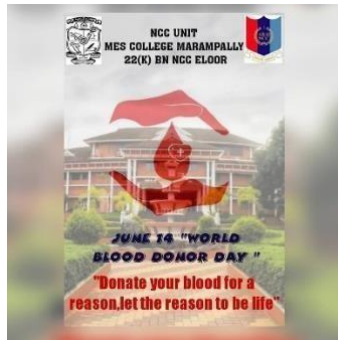
JUNE

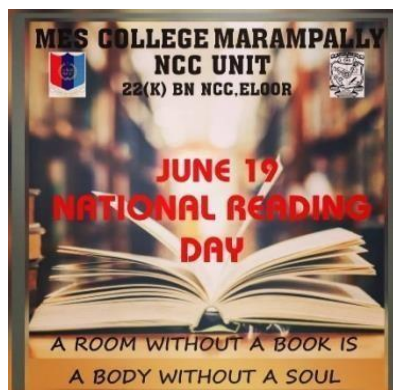
WORLD BLOOD DONOR DAY

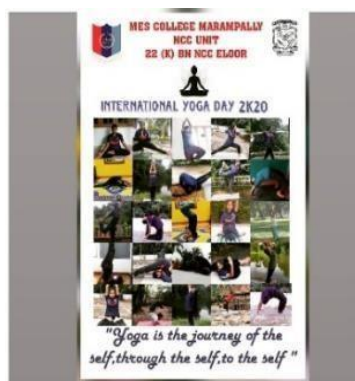
NATIONAL READING DAY

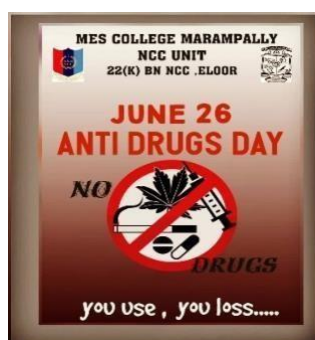
INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY

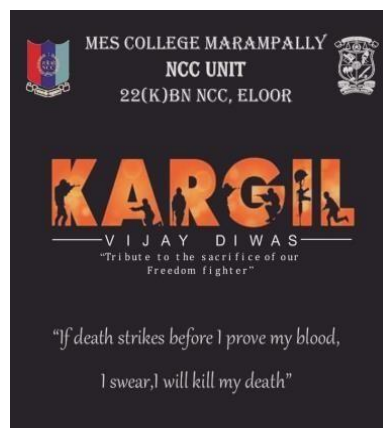
VANQUISH 2020

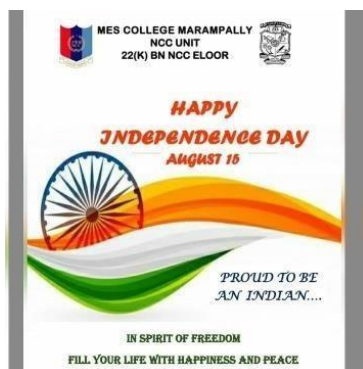

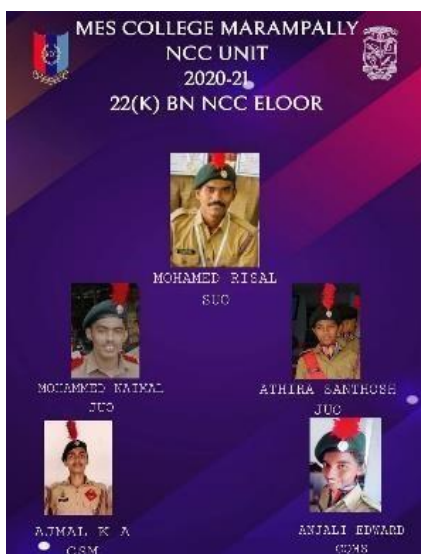
SEPTEMBER

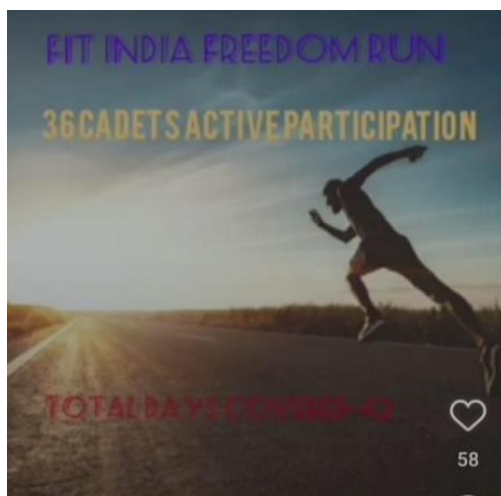
BEST CADET SELECTION

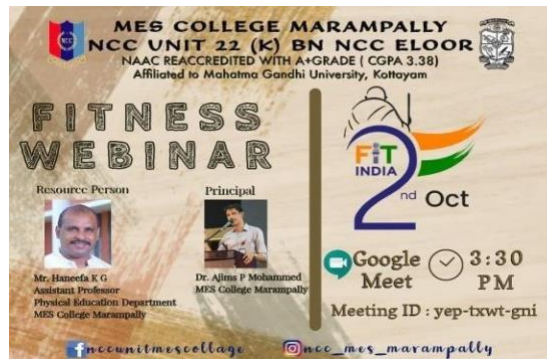
FREEDOM RUN

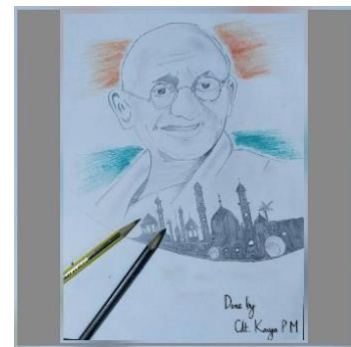
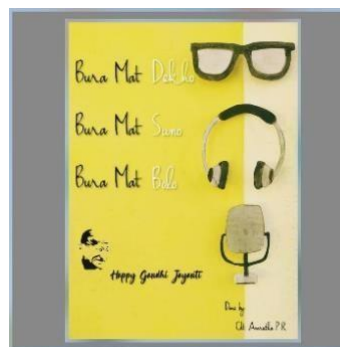
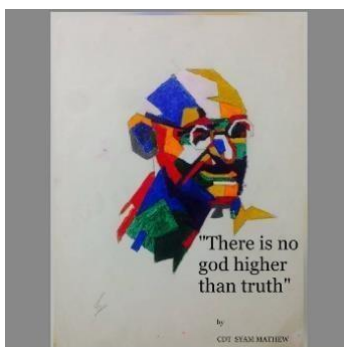
FITNESS WEBINAR

PRE – RDC CAMP

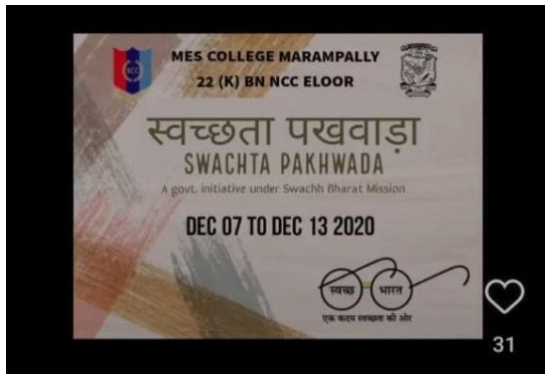

SWACHHTA PAKHWADA

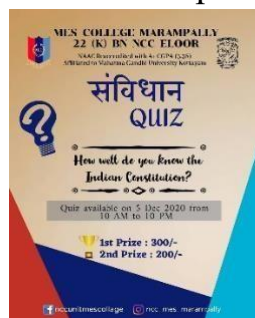
The NCC unit of MES College Marampally conducted an online inauguration **swachhta pakhwada** on Google meet on 5th December 2020. Associate NCC

HONOURING CEREMONY

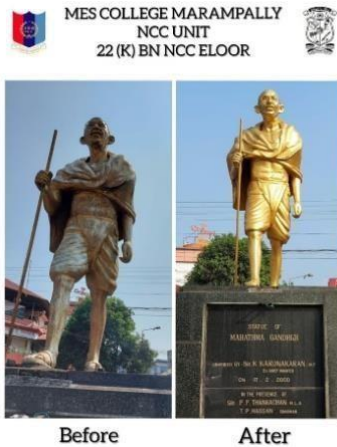

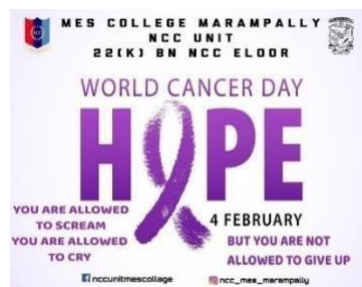
EBSB V SAPATH WEBINAR

REMEMBRANCE OF PULWAMA ATTACK

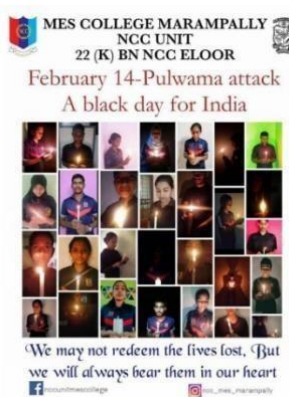
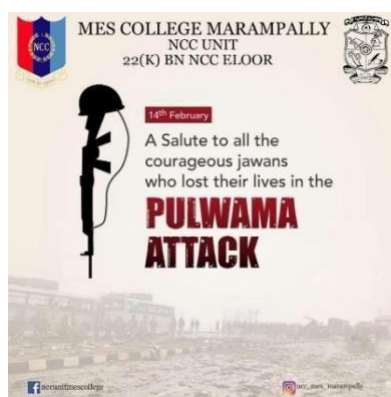

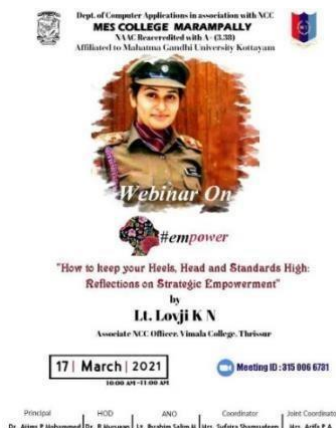
ATC CAMP

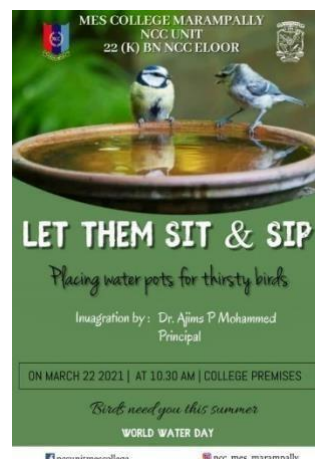
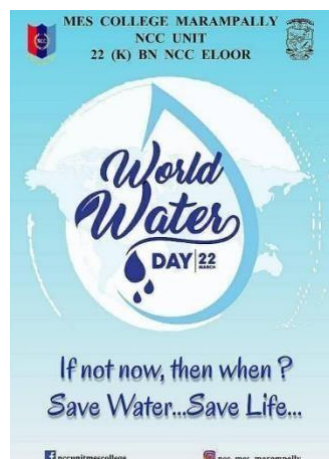


ONLINE EBSB CAMP
