MES COLLEGE MARAMPALLY REMEDIAL COACHING

Annual Report: 2021-22

During the academic year 2021-22, the Department of Logistics Management has conducted 13 hours remedial classes for semester 4 and semester 3 students. A total of 17 students were appeared for the classes in various subjects. The classes were conducted for the subjects of Export and Import policies and procedures, Supply Chain Management, Business Statistics, Principles of Management and Inventory management. The results for the concerned exams were not declared yet.

Department of Electronics has conducted remedial coaching for Sixth semester BSc students (2018 Admn), Fourth Semester BSc students (2019 Admn). The classes were conducted for the subjects Digital Signal Processing, Computer Networks and Opto Electronics for sixth semester classes and Microprocessors for third semester classes. After the online classes due to the corona pandemic the students had the difficulty to follow many classes, and remedial classes were a boon to them.

Department of Mathematics & Statistics conducted remedial coaching on about twenty one courses including core and complimentary Mathematics and Statistics papers.

During the year 2021-22, the Department of Commerce conducted Remedial classes on various subjects to the students of B Com Computer Applications and B Com Finance and Taxation during their university Examinations. The following were the details. For VI semester, Cost Accounting II was handled by Dr. Rafeekamol and Ms. Ramla Beevi, Management Accounting was handled by Ms. Ansala and Ms. Beema, Income Tax by Ms. Rahmath MK and Computer paper was handled by Ms. Febeena and Ms. Sabitha.

For V semester, Cost Accounting by Ms Ramla Beevi and Dr. Rafeeka mol. Tally by Ms. Indu, Financial Management by Ms. Ansala and Income Tax by Ms. Rahmath M K. For IV semester, Corporate Accounting II by Ms. Ansiya and Mr. Praveen EP and Ms. Beema Sainudheen. Quantitative Techniques by Ms. Ansiya and Ms. Rahmath M K. For III Semester, Corporate Accounting I by Mr. Praveen EP, Quantitative Techniques by Ms Ansiya, Ms Rahmath and Ms. Thanseela, GST by Ms. Aswathy and Ms Ansala. For II Semester, Business Regulatory Framework by Ms. Ramla Beevi, PBD by Dr. Rafeekamol

and Rahmath MK and Financial Accounting by Mr. Praveen EP, MS. Ansiya and Ms. Beema. For I Semester, Corporate Regulation and administration by Ms. Ramla, FA I by Mr. Praveen and Beema. The remedial classes were very effective and 90% of the students attended the remedial classes. There is much improvement in the results with the remedial classes.

During 2021-22, a total of 26 remedial classes have been taken for the students of the Department of Industrial Instrumentation and Automation with maximum participation of students who are backward in learning. The classes were organized in such a way that they were very much beneficial for the students in connection with the examination, so the results were very good. More than 90 percentage of the students who participated in the classes got excellent results in the exam. There was an improvement in the individual pass percentage of the concerned subjects and also a significant increase in the pass percentage of the class as a whole.
