








Library facilities are sufficient 290 responses








Syllabus inculcate ethical values 290 responses













64.7% of the teachers agree that the Instructional hours are adequate. 33.3% strongly agree, and 2.0% strongly disagree with the statement.


PO and CO mapping is appropriate



Good balance between theory and application/practical exists





Course content is relevant, up to date and cater to the requirements of the job 313 responses








Curriculum promotes leadership quality 313 responses







Sufficient reference books are available in the library 313 responses





Curriculum inculcate ethical values 313 responses







Curriculum promotes leadership qualities 36 responses





Curriculum ensures professional development 36 responses






The curriculum promotes team work 36 responses







Syllabus has good balance between theory and practical/application ³⁶ responses




