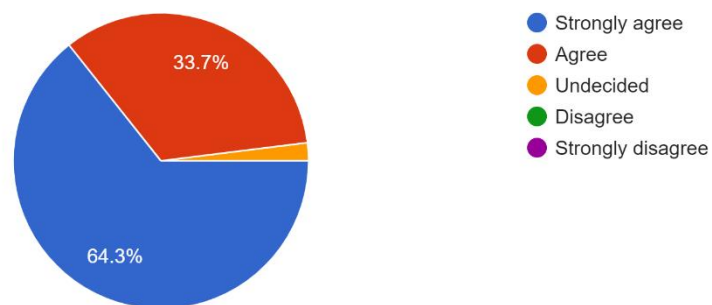

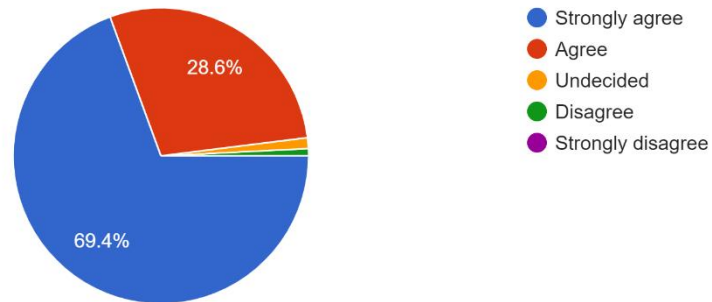
Curriculum content is relevant and need based

Library facilities are sufficient

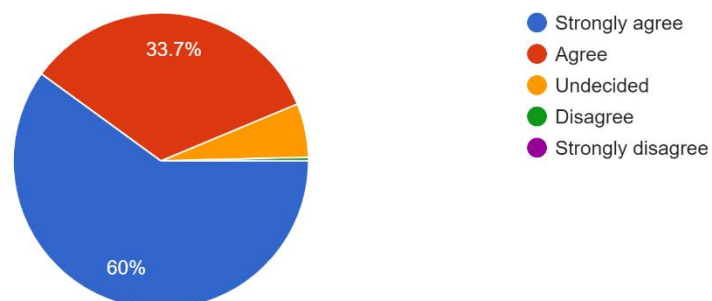

Curriculum fosters entrepreneurship/ skill development/higher learning

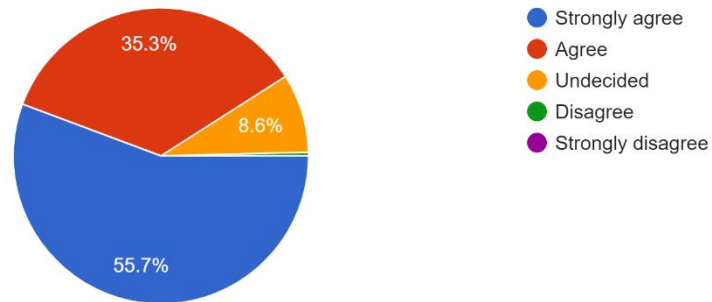

Syllabus inculcate ethical values

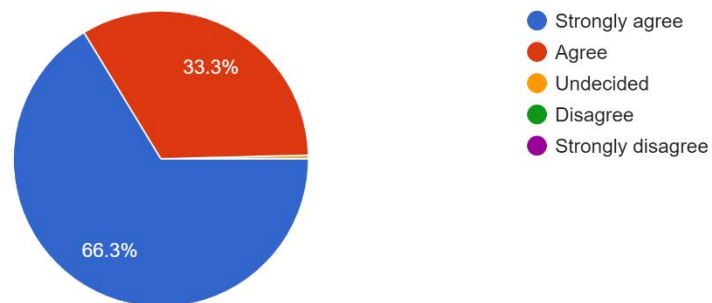

The practical content is sufficient and updated

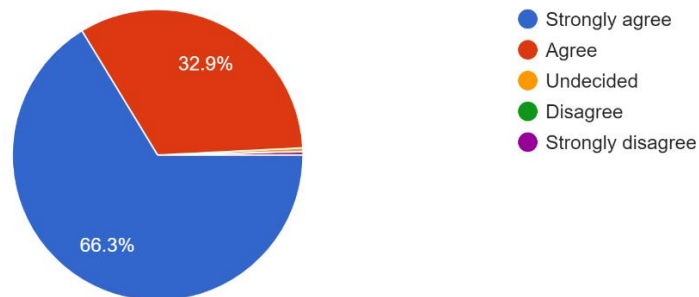

Laboratory facilities and infrastructure are sufficient

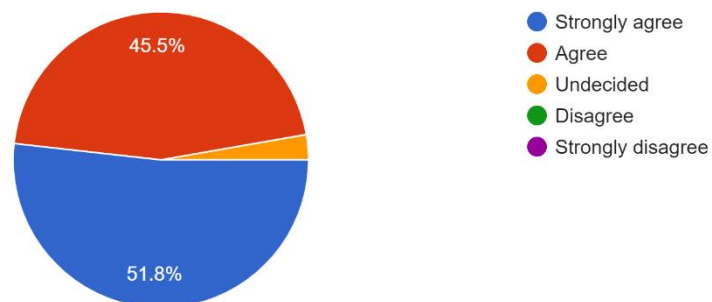

Credit hours are adequate for the course

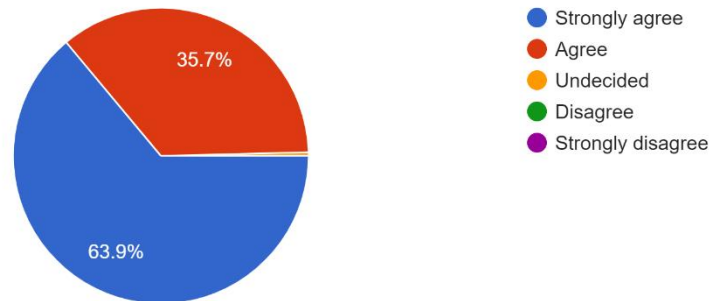

E-content/ online teaching/ICT tools used by the faculty are sufficient

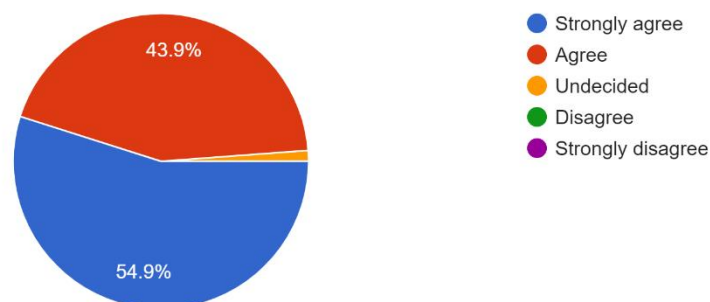

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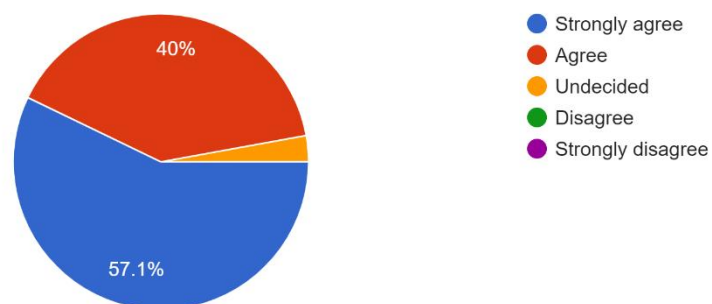

Curriculum is appropriate and need based

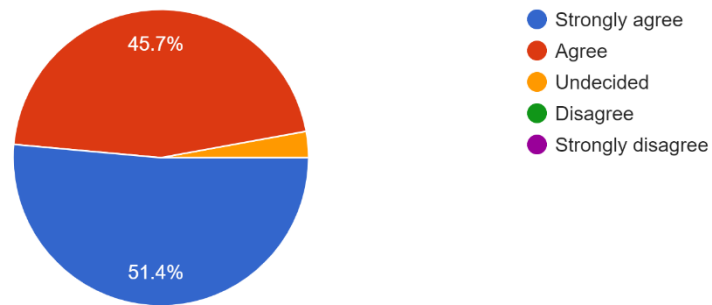

Curriculum is enriched and up to date as compared to that of similar programmes offered by other Universities

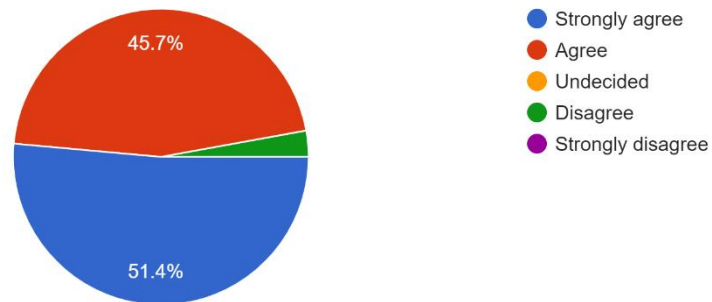

Instructional hours are adequate

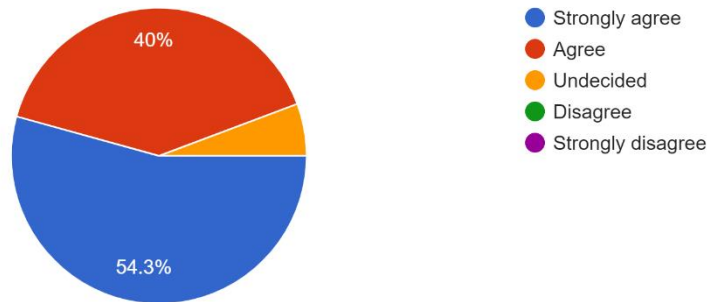

PO and CO mapping is appropriate

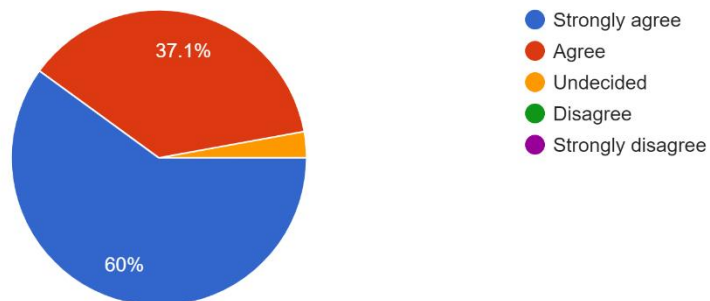

Infrastructure, laboratory and library facilities are adequate

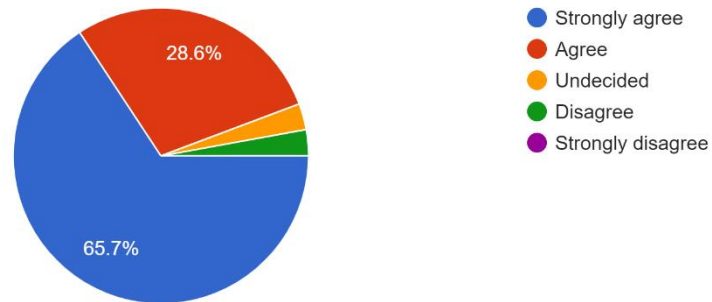

Good balance between theory and application/practical exists

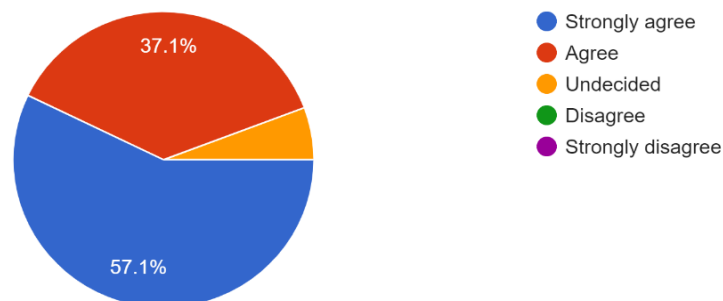

Effective curriculum delivery is achieved by online teaching methods and other enrichment methods

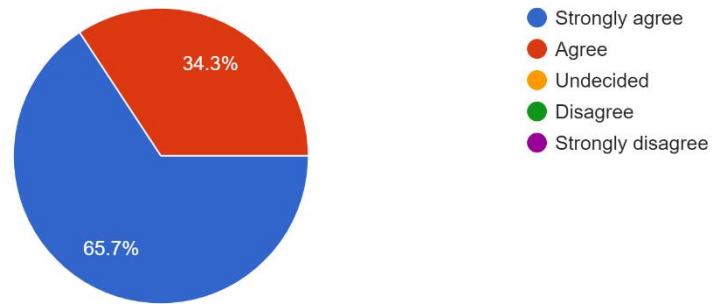

Objectives of Alumni's feedback: Alumni's feedback has three main objectives:

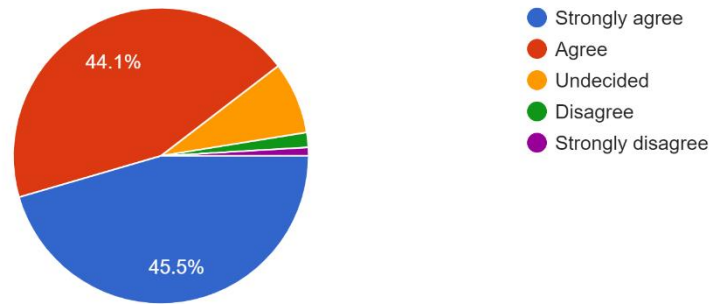
- To enhance the quality of education provided by the college to the students.

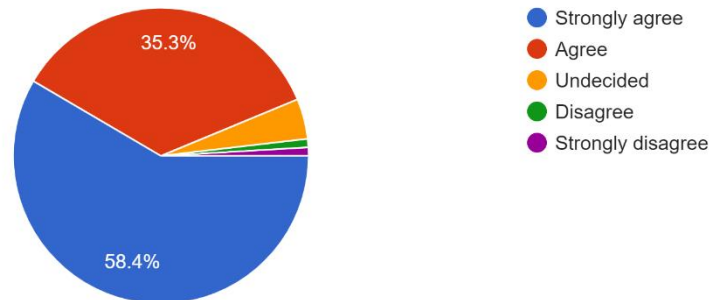

Career orientation in syllabus is sufficient

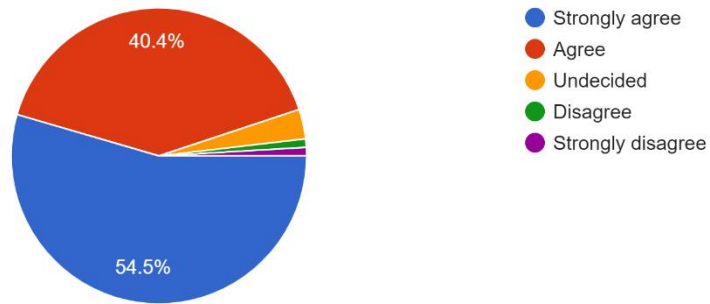

Curriculum promotes leadership quality

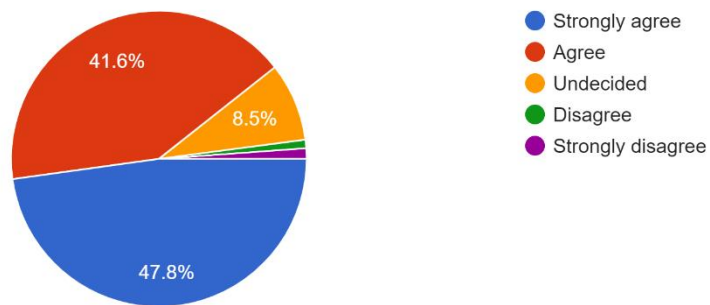

Curriculum ensures professional development

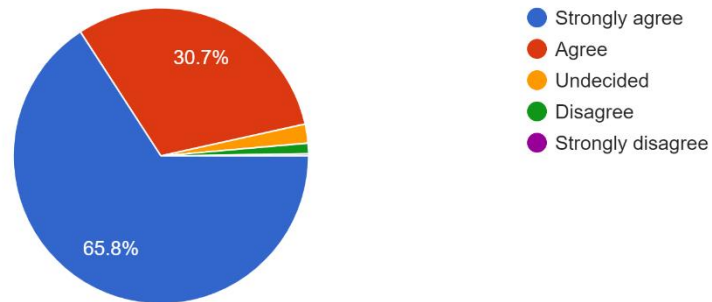

Sufficient reference books are available in the library

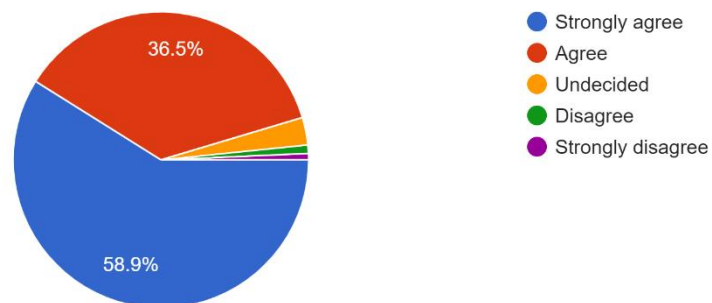

Curriculum supports higher learning

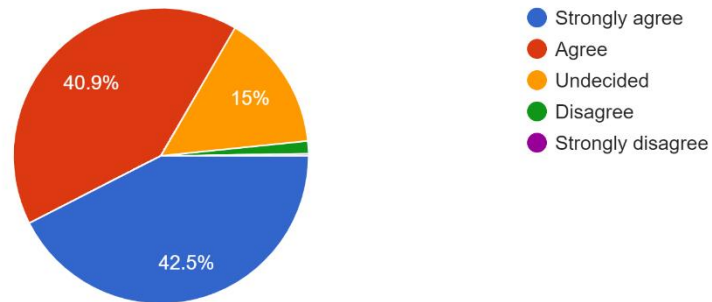

Curriculum inculcate ethical values

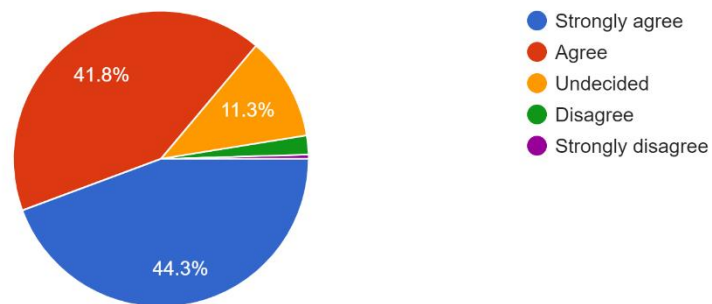

Curriculum fosters entrepreneurship

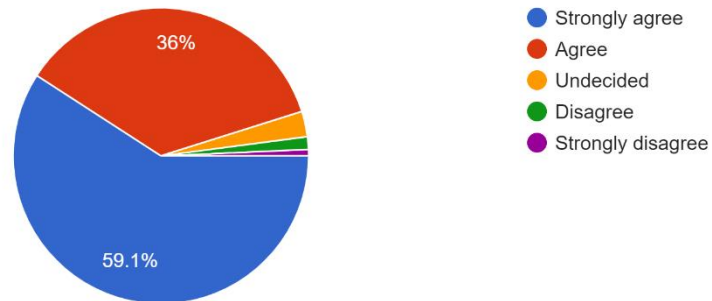

Student support and placement services are good

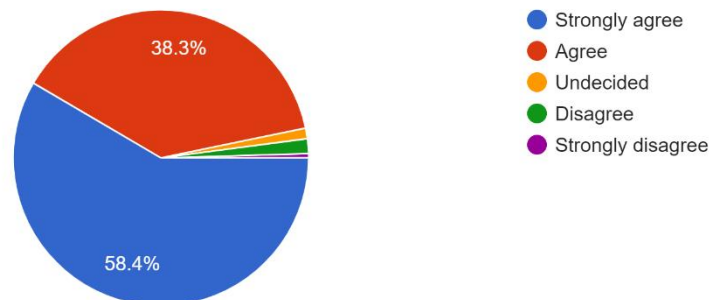
433 responses

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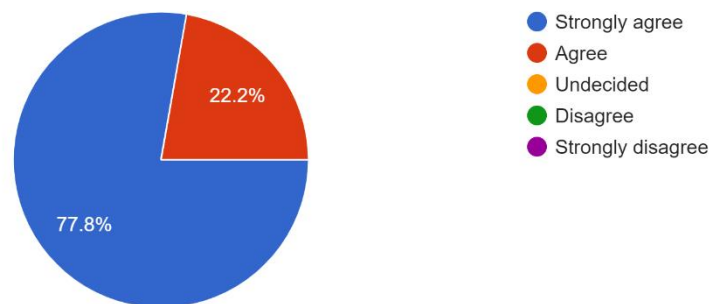

Curriculum has relevance to industrial needs/employment

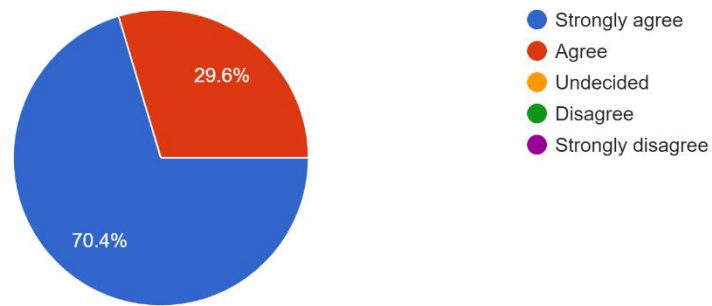

Curriculum promotes leadership qualities

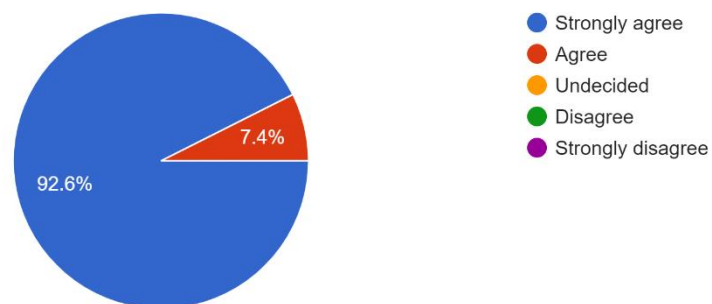

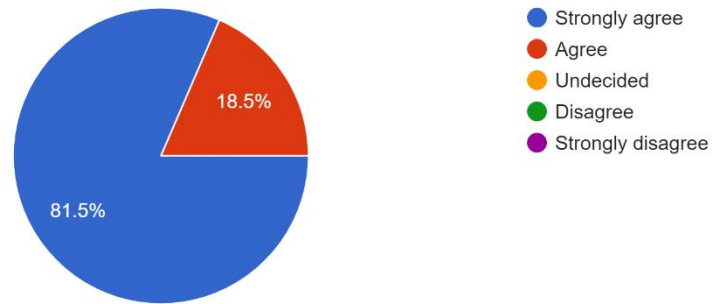

The curriculum promotes team work

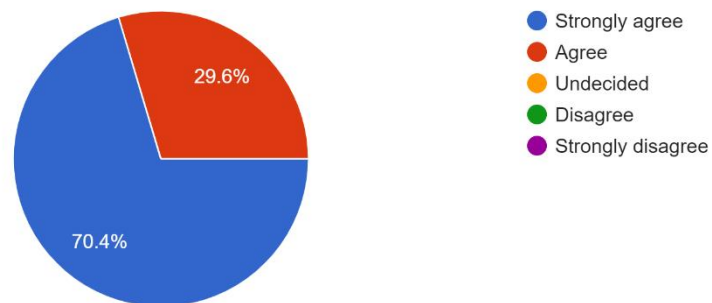

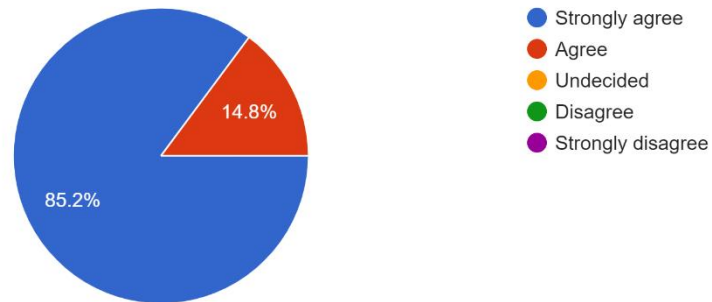

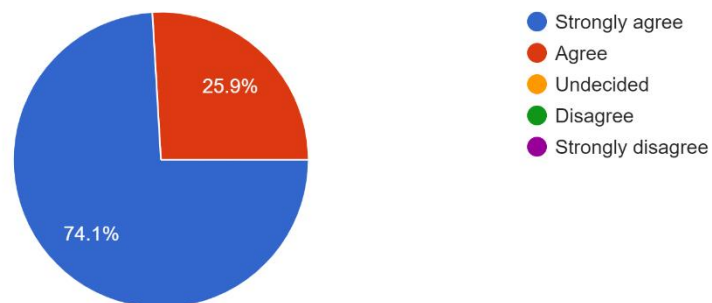

Awareness on recent developments in the field is provided

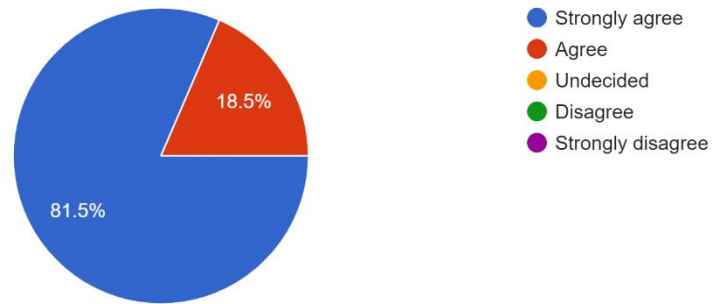
