




MES COLLEGE MARAMPALLY FEEDBACK ANALYSIS ON CURRICULUM ACADEMIC YEAR-2020-21

The college has a very structured and comprehensive feedback collection mechanism from all the stakeholders. The feedback from various stakeholders is analysed and the actions are taken at the department level or the college level as required. The feedback on various parameters is used to improve the various aspects in an efficient student friendly manner.

Methodology:

A questionnaire was prepared with questions based on NAAC and UGC guidelines and feedback on these parameters were collected online using google forms. Feedback was collected Programme-wise from various stakeholders namely students, alumni, parents, faculty and employers under the supervision of IQAC. The responses were analysed on a 5-point Likert scale with responses Strongly agree, Agree, Undecided, Disagree and Strongly disagree. Responses were communicated to the respective departments and Department-wise analysis was done. Necessary actions are taken at the department level and the report submitted to the Principal. Actions which has to be taken at the college level are taken by the Principal after consulting the IQAC and the college council. The feedback analysis for the academic year 20-21 is presented as follows:




STUDENTS FEEDBACK



The student feedback was taken online through google forms. Programme wise feedback on various aspects of the curriculum was collected, analysed and communicated to various departments for further actions to be taken. Approximately 224 students participated in the survey.

Majority of the students were satisfied with the curriculum content; 22.3% strongly agreed and 68% agreed that the curriculum content is relevant and need based. Approximately 30% of the students agreed whereas 68% students strongly agreed that the library facilities are sufficient. The ability of curriculum to foster entrepreunership/ skill development/higher learning was strongly agreed by 26.3% whereas 54% agreed with the aspect. Approximately 18% of students strongly agreed whereas 61% agreed that the syllabus inculcate ethical values. Around 24.5% strongly agreed and 53.5% agreed that the practical content is sufficient and updated. Laboratory facilities and infrastructure are sufficient according to 20% of the students, while 61% of the students agreed whereas 57.5% agreed that the E-contents and ICT tools used by faculty are sufficient.



The faculty feedback was taken online through google forms. Programme wise faculty feedback on various aspects of the curriculum was collected, analysed and communicated to various departments for further actions to be taken. Approximately 58 faculty members participated in the survey.

Majority of the faculty members had the opinion that the curriculum is appropriate and need based; 24 % strongly agreed whereas 63.7% agreed. Around 32.7% of the faculties strongly agreed and 62 % agreed that the course objectives were clear and precise. Approximately 25.8 % of the members strongly agreed and 48.2% agreed that the curriculum is enriched and up to date. About 24 % of the faculty members strongly agreed and 50 % agreed that the instructional hours were adequate. Approximately 24 % strongly agreed whereas 58.6 % agreed PO and CO mapping is appropriate. Around 32.7 % strongly agreed and 50 % agreed that the infrastructure, laboratory and library facilities were adequate.

Approximately 19 % strongly agreed and 60.3 % agreed that good balance between theory and application/practical exists. Almost 24 % of the faculty members strongly agreed and 50 % agreed that effective curriculum delivery could be achieved by online teaching methods and other enrichment methods. Approximately 32.7 % strongly agreed and 62 % agreed that the syllabus completion could be accomplished as per the teaching plan.

EMPLOYER FEED BACK





The employer feedback was taken online through google forms. Employer feedback on various aspects of the curriculum was collected programme wise, analysed and communicated to various departments for further actions to be taken. Approximately 25 respondents participated in the survey.

Among the employers 40 % strongly agreed and 52 % agreed that curriculum has relevance to industrial needs as well as employment. Approximately 56 % strongly agreed and 36 % agreed that curriculum promotes leadership qualities. Around 60 % of the employers strongly agreed and 40% agreed that curriculum ensures professional development. Among the respondents 64 % strongly agreed whereas 32 % agreed that the curriculum promotes team work. Approximately 40 % of the employers strongly agreed and 40 % agreed that the curriculum

promotes innovation ecosystem. Around 44 % employers strongly agreed whereas 44 % agreed that the syllabus has good balance between theory and practicals/application.

The alumni feedback was taken online through google forms. Programme wise faculty feedback of the alumni on various aspects of the curriculum was collected, analysed

and communicated to various departments for further actions to be taken. Approximately 287 respondents participated in the survey.

Approximately 34.4 % of the alumni strongly agreed and 55.4 % agreed that course content is relevant, up to date and cater to the requirements of the job. Around 34 % of the alumni strongly agreed and 53.3 % agreed that the career orientation in syllabus is sufficient. Quality of teaching was strongly appreciated by 64.8% alumni and appreciated by 32.4 %. Around 57.8 % of the alumni strongly agreed and 36.2 % agreed that the overall academic atmosphere in the college is good. About 46 % alumni strongly agreed and 42.8 % agreed that sufficient reference books are available in the library. Approximately 47.7 % alumni strongly agreed and 43.5 % agreed that the curriculum supports higher learning. Around 32.4 % strongly agreed and 46 % agreed that the curriculum fosters entrepreunership. Approximately 32.8 % alumni strongly agreed and 44.2 % agreed that the student support and placement services are good in this college. Around 34.4 % alumni strongly agreed whereas 46 % agreed that the course content is applicable to real life situations.

In response to the invaluable feedback received from a diverse range of stakeholders, the institution conducted a meticulous analysis of the curriculum for the academic year 2020-21. The insights garnered from this feedback catalyzed targeted actions, implemented at both the department and college levels, with a focus on enhancing the curriculum in an effective and student-centric manner. The following actions were implemented based on the feedback analysis:

Inclusion of Skill-Based Programmes and Certificate Courses:
