The student feedback was taken online through google forms. Programme wise feedback on various aspects of the curriculum was collected, analysed and communicated to various departments for further actions to be taken. Approximately 747 students participated in the survey.


Majority of the students were satisfied with the curriculum content; 16% strongly agreed and 66% agreed that the curriculum content is relevant and need based. Approximately 23% of the students agreed whereas 56% students strongly agreed that the library facilities are sufficient. The ability of curriculum to foster entrepreunership/ skill development/higher learning was strongly agreed by 12% whereas 57 % agreed with the aspect. Approximately 13% of students strongly agreed whereas 59 % agreed

that the syllabus inculcate ethical values. Around 17 % strongly agreed and 53 % agreed that the practical content is sufficient and updated. Laboratory facilities and infrastructure are sufficient according to 20% of the students, while 61 % of the students agreed with it. Approximately 19.6 % of the students strongly agreed and 58 % agreed that the credit hours are adequate for the course. Around 23 % of the students strongly agreed by faculty are sufficient.



The faculty feedback was taken online through google forms. Programme wise faculty feedback on various aspects of the curriculum was collected, analysed and communicated to various departments for further actions to be taken. Approximately 73 faculty members participated in the survey.

Majority of the faculty members had the opinion that the curriculum is appropriate and need based; 19 % strongly agreed whereas 71% agreed. Around 31% of the faculties strongly agreed and 63 % agreed that the course objectives were clear and precise. Approximately 19 % of the members strongly agreed and % agreed that the curriculum is enriched and up to date. About 18 % of the faculty members strongly agreed and 49 % agreed that the instructional hours were adequate. Approximately 18 % strongly agreed whereas 57% agreed PO and CO mapping is appropriate. Around 26 % strongly agreed and 56 % agreed that the infrastructure, laboratory and library facilities were adequate.

Approximately 21 % strongly agreed and 54 % agreed that good balance between theory and application/practical exists. Almost 21 % of the faculty members strongly agreed and 56 % agreed that effective curriculum delivery could be achieved by online teaching methods and other enrichment methods. Approximately 29 % strongly agreed and 53 % agreed that the syllabus completion could be accomplished as per the teaching plan.


The alumni feedback was taken online through google forms. Programme wise faculty feedback of the alumni on various aspects of the curriculum was collected, analysed and communicated to various departments for further actions to be taken. Approximately 325 respondents participated in the survey.

Approximately 36.4 % of the alumni strongly agreed and 53.4 % agreed that course content is relevant, up to date and cater to the requirements of the job. Around 39 % of the alumni strongly agreed and 48.3 % agreed that the career orientation in syllabus is

sufficient. Quality of teaching was strongly appreciated by 64.8% alumni and appreciated by 32.4%. Around 59.8% of the alumni strongly agreed and 34.2% agreed that the overall academic atmosphere in the college is good. About 48% alumni strongly agreed and 40.8% agreed that sufficient reference books are available in the library. Approximately 45.7% alumni strongly agreed and 45.5% agreed that the curriculum supports higher learning. Around 35.4% strongly agreed and 43% agreed that the curriculum fosters entrepreneurship. Approximately 34.8% alumni strongly agreed and 42.2% agreed that the student support and placement services are good in this college.

Around 36.4 % alumni strongly agreed whereas 44 % agreed that the course content is applicable to real life situations.
