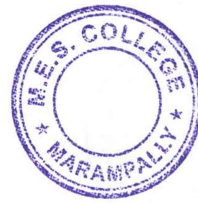
Action Taken Report: Academic Audit 2019-20


The Academic Audit held on June 17 and 18, 2020 provided valuable insights into the institution's performance and highlighted areas for improvement. The summary of the action taken report is outlined below:

- Postgraduate students are required to complete at least one NPTEL course per semester.
- The application for postgraduate programs in social work, psychology, etc., has been submitted to broaden academic offerings.
- Faculty members are encouraged to create two to three e-contents related to their assigned courses annually.
- All faculty members are advised to register for PhD programs to enhance their academic profile.
- The tutorial system has been reinforced to provide academic and psycho-social counseling to students effectively.
- Faculty members are motivated to publish papers in reputable journals by providing incentives for publications.
- Faculty members are instructed to include their affiliation with MES College Marampally when contributing articles to esteemed journals.
- The Department of Industrial Instrumentation and Automation's Plastic Shredder Machine project for Henrey Baker College, Melukavu, has been acknowledged.
- The construction of the new block has been monitored, and it is scheduled to be operational soon.
- Additional classrooms and amenities have been created to accommodate the expanding programs and student population.
- Student scholarships and capability enhancement schemes continue to be funded to support students' academic and career development.
- Efforts to resolve student grievances and prevent cases of harassment and ragging will be sustained.

- Sports and cultural activities will be further promoted to encourage student participation and achievements.
- E-Governance through TCS software and MES Dkatia software has streamlined administrative processes and financial operations.
